Performance Notes

Emmanuel is a meditative setting for choir and assembly based on Isaiah 45:8, the Entrance Antiphon for the 4th Sunday of Advent, and also may be sung anytime during the Advent season. The setting is in the form of a sung mantra and includes a variety of textures, colors and options for repetition. After the mantra's first statement by the cantor, it may be repeated by choir and/or assembly, either alternating or together. A contrasting section in C minor for *a cappella* choir (Mantra 3) provides a respite for the assembly. A simplified version of this section for SATB without cantor is also included in this octavo.

If the mantra is sung in unison, accompaniment is especially desirable. Organ and solo instrument (flute suggested) provide musical color by introducing the mantra and providing a short interlude between the *a cappella* section and the final mantra.
