Psalm 145 is one of the common psalms for Ordinary Time. It also appears in the lectionary on the 5th Sunday of Easter in Cycle C, and in Ordinary Time on the 14th, 18th, and 25th Sundays in Cycle A, the 17th Sunday in Cycle B, and the 31st Sunday in Cycle C. This psalm can also be used for the Rite of Marriage. This setting should be performed with quiet confidence, never becoming too loud or dramatic.
