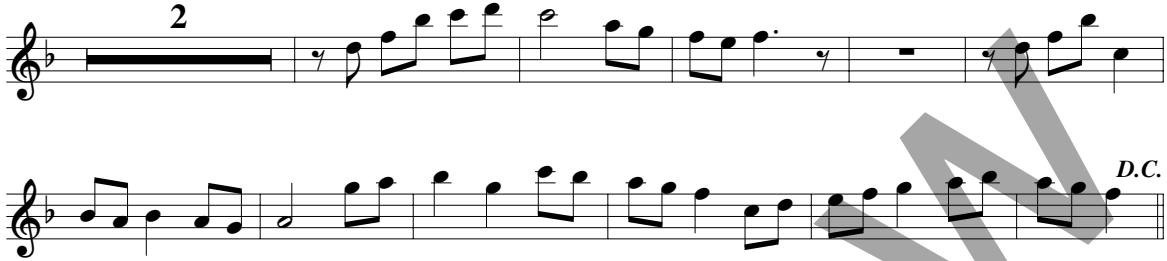

Composer Notes

You Are Present

This song uses six scriptural titles of Jesus along with repetitive phases to celebrate some of the ways Jesus continues to be with us. It is an obvious choice as a Communion song or a hymn for Easter time, but try using just one verse as a repeated acclamation during a prayer service. For example, in a school prayer service leading up to the feast of Our Lord Jesus Christ the King, use verse five as an acclamation before and after the Scripture or between verses of a psalm. "Lord, Jesus, King of kings, you are present on the earth. With no throne or princely rings, you have shown the way, King of kings."
