

Composer Notes

If I, Your Lord and Master

This is one of the antiphons for the *Mandatum*, the ceremony that gives the name to Maundy Thursday, as it is called in Britain and Ireland. The tempo chosen depends on how the verses will sound; the second half of the verse must not be rushed. The words must be heard and understood, at a time when people's attention may be occupied by watching the ritual. Sing with the desire to communicate and use *rubato*. The accompanist should follow.
