

MAGIS

Composer Notes

“Friends in the Lord” can be performed by SATB or unison choir. If unison choir is used, sing Verse 1 one time only. On Verse 3, sing from the unison choir staff. Make sure that in the first two times through the phrase, “friends in the Lord,” the word “in” is sung on a B natural, as is indicated here and in the guitar/vocal. The keyboard part has cue notes that support this alternate melody. The full choir version has the choir singing an A minor chord on this note.

MAGiS is Latin for “more.” The MAGiS program offers experiences in the tradition of St. Ignatius of Loyola that engage young adults who are open to more of their life and more for our world. MAGiS08 is the MAGiS program at World Youth Day Sydney, Australia, in July 2008, and builds on previous Ignatian programs at World Youth Days in Paris, Rome, Toronto and Cologne.

This international program consists of a range of “experiments,” each of which involves groups of 25 young adults from at least three different nationalities living and working together in community for 7-10 days around Australia and Asia. At the conclusion of the experiments will be a 3-day gathering in Sydney of all 1,500 MAGiS08 participants, followed immediately by the Sydney World Youth Day program.
