## Composer Notes

This setting of The Lord's Prayer may be sung:

- by the assembly singing unaccompanied in unison (melody alone)
- by the assembly singing in unison with a choir singing harmony
- by the assembly singing in unison with the keyboard playing the harmony

When sung during Mass, the priest may sing the prayer in symbolism, or say it over the accompaniment. The assembly continues singing "For the kingdom..."

When sung during Morning or Evening Prayer, the prayer should stop at "...deliver us from evil."
