# Liturgical Note

The music for the hymns,

“Praise to Christ Who Comes for Us” (Palm/Passion Sunday)

“Praise the Gift of God in Christ” (Holy Thursday)

“Praise the Cross of Jesus Christ” (Good Friday)

“Praise the Love That Conquers Death” (Easter)

is intended to unify the liturgies of Palm Sunday and the Triduum and, at the same time, simplify the task of parish musicians and choirs. While the texts change for each of the four days, the music remains the same, thus fostering familiarity and participation. The Easter hymn can also be used throughout the Easter season.

The “Hymn of the Holy Oils” is intended for the Rite for Parish Reception of the Holy Oils on Holy Thursday. It uses the same music as the *Ritual Music for the Chrism Mass (The Blessing of the Oils)*, also available from the 2007 edition 20772, which some parishioners may have sung earlier during the diocesan ritual at the cathedral.
