Composer Notes

I first wrote the intercessions for the “Vigil for the Deceased,” based on the Dies Irae (Chant Mode I), for my mother’s funeral in 2001. The litany was later added for the section “Order of Christian Funerals” in *Journeysongs*, Second Edition (OCP 510).

The Order of Christian Funerals (OCF) indicates “Having heard the word of God proclaimed and preached, the assembly responds at the vigil and at the funeral liturgy with prayers of intercession for the deceased and all the dead, for the family and all who mourn, and for all in the assembly. The holy people of God, confident in the communion of saints, exercise their royal priesthood by joining together in this prayer for all those who have died” (OCF 29).

The “Prayer of Intercession, Litany” is found in the Vigil for the Deceased ritual at OCF 78, 94; the “Litany for the Transfer of the Body to the Church or to the Place of Committal” is at OCF 123; and the “Prayer of Intercession, Litany: Vigil for a Deceased Child” is at OCF 260.

At the heart of these celebrations are the Liturgy of the Word and the Prayer of Intercession. These litanies become preeminent when chanted, so the assembly may fully exercise their baptismal priesthood while offering prayers to God for the salvation of all who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith (cf. *Sing to the Lord*, Divine Worship 115c, 171).
