Composer Notes

“Alive in One Spirit” was commissioned for the occasion of the celebration of confirmation and the Twentieth Anniversary of the Diocese of San José, California (May 27, 2001). It grew out of reflection on 1 Corinthians 12, the first option for the second reading of Pentecost Sunday (A, B, C). Two sets of verses are provided, one for gathering or preparation, the other for sending forth. As I mentioned earlier with regard to the song, “*Veni Creator Spiritus*,” a song invoking the Spirit is appropriate generally for the entrance rite. In gathering we manifest a unity coming from the Spirit. “For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body...and we were all given to drink of one Spirit” (1 Corinthians 12:34). Similarly, the sending forth verses of this song make it generally appropriate for dismissal, as the Spirit propels the Church’s mission “you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses...to the ends of the earth” (Acts of the Apostles 1:8).
