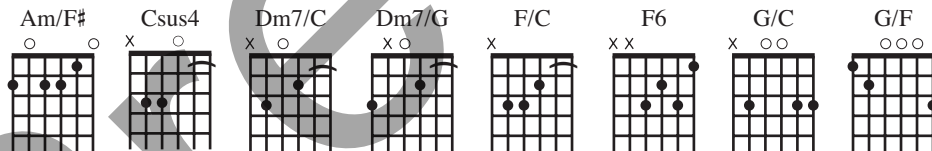
Sing un - to the Lord!
