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## Performance Notes

*Banquet Of Love* is a communion song designed to give the music leadership a number of performance options. The assembly refrain may be sung in responsorial style, alternating with the verses, or the refrain may become an ostinato. Sing the first few refrains in unison, with simple accompaniment, then add SATB voices and instruments to increase the intensity. For variety, I have provided a set of keyboard variations, but do not hesitate to improvise your own!
