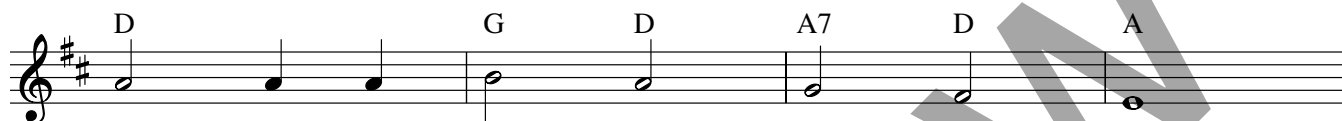


# JESUS SHALL REIGN
