Composer Notes

Pentecost Sequence: Performance Notes

Here are two options for a clear transition from the sequence into the Gospel acclamation. Of these two, option one is the most preferable:

- 1) At verse 4 or 5 of the sequence, begin a grand procession of the Gospel Book through the assembly, with the cantor gesturing for all to stand. As the book arrives at the ambo, the sequence culminates in the singing of the Gospel acclamation.
- 2) If a Gospel procession is not done, sing the sequence through to the end, pause slightly; the cantor gestures for all to stand and begins the alleluia refrain.
