Composer Notes

We desired to create a piece that captures the spirit of daily liturgical prayer and could begin and end the day with the same melody. We use "Magnificat" to end evening prayer, for adoration experiences, parish meetings and gatherings, and to connect our hearts to the rhythm of the prayer of the Church. The "Magnificat" can be sung gently and prayerfully but it can also be done like the "Benedictus," more majestically and powerfully.

Musical notation does not always capture the elements of contemporary style and interpretation; we encourage you to use the recording for stylistic ideas and approaches.
