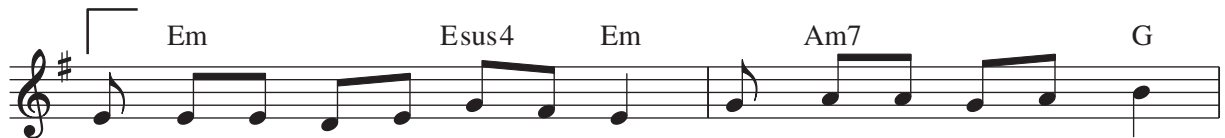


# WHERE CHARITY AND LOVE PREVAIL
