*For variety, a second voice may sing measures 1-6 in parallel organum, a perfect 4th below the melody, in one or more verses.

Note: Here are two options for a clear transition from the sequence into the Gospel acclamation:

1. At verse 4 or 5 of the sequence, begin a procession of the Gospel Book from the altar to the ambo, with the cantor gesturing for all to stand. As the book arrives at the ambo, the sequence culminates in the singing of the Gospel acclamation.
2. If a Gospel procession is not done, sing the sequence through to the end, pause slightly; the cantor gestures for all to stand and begins the alleluia refrain.
