The text to “Love the Lord, Your God” is inspired by Deuteronomy 6:5: “Therefore, you shall love the LORD, your God, with your whole heart, and with your whole being, and with your whole strength.” This commandment forms the verses of the Jewish *Shema* prayer, which is quoted with some variation by Jesus in the Gospels of Matthew (22:34–40) and Luke (10:29–37). In both passages, Jesus is responding to the Pharisees who are testing him to see whether or not he knows which commandment in the law is the greatest. Jesus responds by citing the love of God as the greatest, and then adds the love of neighbor as the second. He follows these commandments with the popular Parable of the Good Samaritan. Consider singing this for the Sixth Sunday of Easter (B); the Seventh Sunday of Easter (B); the 15th Sunday OT (C); Liturgy of the Hours; Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe; Presentation of the Lord, and Transfiguration.
